PROGRAM NOTES

Prelude & Fugue......J.S. Bach

Composed in 1722, Johann Sebastian Bach included these two keyboard pieces as part of The Well-Tempered Clavier.

A prelude is a short piece, typically as a preface to a larger work to follow. A fugue is a piece that combines two or more voices, and is built on a recurring 'subject.' Listen in this piece for the 'subject' to appear in one of four voices: Soprano (highest,) Alto (high-middle,) Tenor (low-middle,) or even in the Bass (lowest!)
